Multiple deaths in a school shooting in Oregon

In the US, at least <u>thirteen</u> people have been <u>killed</u> in a shooting in Oregon State. It's understood the gunman who's believed to be in his twenties is dead.

Oregon Attorney General Ellen Rosenblum said at least <u>twenty</u> others were wounded at the Umpqua Community College Campus of <u>3,000 pupils</u> in Roseburg, Oregon.

It's understood one the wounded was a <u>female</u> who'd been <u>shot</u> in the <u>chest</u>; there is no immediate <u>information</u> on the condition of the other <u>wounded</u> victims.

The Douglas County Sheriff's office said on one of the social media site that <u>officers</u> had responded to a shooting at the college following <u>emergency</u> calls at just after <u>half past ten</u> in the morning, local time.

The shooting is the latest incident of <u>gun violence</u> in the United States, raising demands for more <u>gun control</u> and more effective treatment of the mentally ill.

Recent episodes of gun violence include the <u>massacre</u> of <u>nine</u> people at a South Carolina church last Spring and the <u>killing</u> of <u>five</u> US servicemen in Chattanooga, Tennessee.
